## Main speakers



**Svanhildur Svavars Kristjansson M.Sc.** is a autism consultant and certified TEACCH trainer. For over 35 years, Ms. Kristjansson has been involved with autism education and public speaking. She grew up in Iceland with a handicapped brother

and was thus, first exposed to the field in her youth. Her father was also the founder of an institution in Iceland for special needs children. Ms. Kristjansson's first job after finishing Teachers University in Iceland was as the principal of a school for physically handicapped students. Some of the students had diagnoses as multi handicapped, when in fact they had autism. Inspired by the children who had trouble communicating, she decided to pursue a career in special education and later as communication specialist. Svanhildur received her education from Iceland, Norway and North Carolina.



**Dr. Gary B. Mesibov** is a Professor Emeritus of Psychology in the Departments of Psychiatry and Psychology at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, where he served on the faculty for 35

years. He was the Director of Division TEACCH at the University of North Carolina from 1992 until 2010. This internationally recognized statewide program is one of a kind in its pioneering approaches to service, treatment, training, research and the education of individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorders. Dr. Mesibov has received degrees from Stanford University (A.B.), The University of Michigan (M.A.), Brandeis University (Ph.D.), and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (Postdoctoral Fellowship). Dr. Mesibov is a licensed Psychologist in the state of North Carolina.
